<u>Lesson</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 'Starter' (SLIDE 2) &amp; 'Answers' (SLIDE 3). Students to answer 4 questions in line (vertically/horizontally/diagonally). Students to self-mark with answers.</li><li>• 'Video' (SLIDE 4) Right-click on the 'video' link at the bottom of the page to open the video in a new window. Pause the video when prompted to allow students to copy the notes and try the relevant tasks (see below).</li><li>• 'Notes' (SLIDE 5) The complete notes discussed in the video.</li><li>• 'Worksheet – I'm giving it a try!' (SLIDE 6) &amp; 'Answers' (SLIDE 7) The most straight forward of the 3 tasks. Students self-mark with answers. Students complete the reflective section at the bottom of the task to evaluate their confidence.</li><li>• 'Worksheet – I'm building my confidence!' (SLIDE 8) &amp; 'Answers' (SLIDE 9) The slightly more difficult of the 3 tasks. Students self-mark with answers. Students complete the reflective section at the bottom of the task to evaluate their confidence.</li><li>• 'Worksheet – I'm ready for anything!' (SLIDE 10) &amp; 'Answers' (SLIDE 11) The most difficult of the 3 tasks. Students self-mark with answers. Students complete the reflective section at the bottom of the task to evaluate their confidence.</li><li>• 'Extension' (SLIDE 12) &amp; 'Answers' (SLIDE 13) To project for those students who have completed all of the previous tasks or to provide the whole class with an end of lesson challenge.</li><li>• 'Homework' (SLIDE 14) &amp; 'Answers' (SLIDE 15)</li></ul>
